## 7-DAY ITINERARY

### Thu, February 18 DEPART THE UNITED STATES

Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

### Fri, February 19 REYKJAVIK ARRIVAL

After landing at Reykjavik Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Your tour director will welcome you to Iceland and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Transfer to your hotel, check in and enjoy some free time to settle into your room. In the afternoon, sample some of the best traditional dishes that Iceland has to offer on a leisurely food walking tour of the lively city. Visit some favorite hotspots, family-owned business and even secret hangouts while trying some distinctive Icelandic cuisine. Head back to your hotel in time to join your fellow travelers for a delightful welcome dinner in the hotel restaurant.

**DINNER & OVERNIGHT:** HOTEL REYKJAVIK SAGA, REYKJAVIK

### Sat, February 20 SOUTH SHORE TOUR

Today, embark on the South Shore Tour, which is perfect for nature lovers of all ages. Along the way, stop to visit Sólheimasandur, a striking plain of black sand and pebbles created by glacial activity. The site is known for the wreckage of a US Navy DC-3 plane, which crashed on the beach in 1973. While here, take the Icelandia shuttle to the famous Sólheimasandur DC-3 plane wreck for an up-close view of the iconic and eerie landmark. Next, travel to view Skógafoss, one of the most beautiful waterfalls in Iceland. Due to the amount of spray the waterfall consistently produces, a single or double rainbow is normally visible on sunny days. Then, continue on to view the picturesque Seljalandsfoss Waterfall, which has a pathway leading behind it giving visitors a chance to view the falls from within. Transfer to your hotel in Vatnajökull National Park, check in and settle into your room. This evening, gather with your group in the hotel restaurant for dinner.

**DINNER & OVERNIGHT:** FOSSHOTEL GLACIER LAGOON, VATNAJOKULL NATIONAL PARK

### Sun, February 21 REYNISFJARA BEACH

This morning, discover Reynisfjara's black-sand beach and rock formations along the magical legend of its history. The basalt columns are similar to the Giant's Causeway in Ireland. Next, visit the Fjadrargljúfur Gorge, a breathtaking massive canyon that was created by a progressive erosion coming from water from glaciers. Then, travel to visit Skaftafell National Park to view its enormous glaciers or the Svartifoss Waterfall flowing down over black basalt columns. Filled with natural wonders, Skaftafell National Park also boasts a snow-capped volcano and magnificent wilderness areas and woodlands. Return to your hotel in Vatnajökull National Park in time to dine in the hotel restaurant with your group. After dinner, escape the bustling city for a couple of hours and head to a location that is optimal for viewing the Northern Lights (subject to weather conditions). It is recommended that you wear layers, including headwear and gloves along with sturdy footwear. Also, don't forget to bring your camera as there will be plenty of opportunities for photos.

### Mon, February 22 JOKULSARLON GLACIER LAGOON

After breakfast, set off via a super jeep to an ice cave, where you will have the opportunity to witness the unique ice formation and admire the many blue hues (weather permitting). Following, journey to visit Jokulsarlon Glacier Lagoon, a crystal-blue glacial lake dotted with icebergs. Marvel as you witness small icebergs flowing into the Atlantic or onto the black-sand beach. Transfer to your hotel in Hvalsöllum, check in and settle into your room. Tonight, dine in the hotel restaurant with your fellow travelers.

**DINNER & OVERNIGHT:** LOA HOTEL, HVOLSÖLLUR

### Tue, February 23 GOLDEN CIRCLE

Departing Hvalsöllum, set off on a panoramic drive around the scenic Golden Ring, which in its entirety is over 190 miles long. Along the way, stop at Fridheimar Tomato Farm to have a tasty light lunch with your fellow travelers. Then, journey to The Laugaras Lagoon to enjoy the Lerki package, where you will have access to their outdoor wellness areas, geothermal lagoon, two saunas and a cold plunge pool. Following, travel through Thingvellir National Park, a place of extraordinary natural beauty and steeped in Iceland's past. Thingvellir is the original site of the oldest existing parliament in the world. Continue on to view Strokkur Geysir, Iceland's most active geyser, which sprays hot water and steam into the air every 10 minutes. You might have the opportunity to witness this spectacular display of geothermal power. Transfer to your hotel in Reykjavik, check in and spend the balance of the day at leisure for individual pursuits and dining.

### Wed, February 24 RETURN TO THE UNITED STATES

All too soon, your vacation has come to its final day. Transfer to Reykjavik Airport in good time to check in for your flight. You may do some last-minute shopping at the duty-free stores before boarding your aircraft and flying back to the United States.
